### College Scholarship Application Information

**Scholarships are available at Saint Kentigern College for boys and girls who wish to enter at Year 9 in 2020.**

**Scholarship Applications for 2020 close Friday 29 March 2019  
Academic/Old Collegians/Boarding Scholarship candidates must sit a test or an assessment on Friday 12 April 2019**

- **Academic Scholarships.** Up to 10 scholarships are available for top academic students and also for students who have already achieved outstanding distinction in areas such as music and the arts. These scholarships range from 25% to 50% of the tuition fees.
- **Old Collegians Scholarship.** This is the gift of the Saint Kentigern Old Collegians Association to celebrate the 50th Jubilee of the College. The recipient must be the child of an Old Collegian or have a strong family connection to an Old Collegian. The Old Collegians Jubilee Scholarship covers 33.3% of the tuition fees. There is only one Old Collegian Jubilee Scholarship awarded each year.
- **Boarding Scholarships.** Scholarships of up to 50% of boarding fees are available for talented students who need to board at Bruce House to take advantage of the opportunities offered at Saint Kentigern College.
- **Music Scholarships.** Scholarships of up to 50% are available for exceptional musically talented students.
- **Performing Arts Scholarships.** Scholarships of up to 50% are available for exceptionally talented students in Dance or Drama.
- **Sports Scholarships.** This application form is NOT for Sports Scholarships. To apply, please email the Director of Sport attaching the student's sporting CV to [ask@saintkentigern.com](mailto:ask@saintkentigern.com).

Scholarships are available for five years, subject to annual review. Continuation is subject to good academic performance, exemplary behaviour, and participation in the overall life of the College. Applicants must be New Zealand citizens or permanent residents attending a school in New Zealand.

All families make some financial contribution to their child's education. This includes the balance of the tuition fees and a notebook computer as well as transport and school uniform costs.

#### **Bursary Applications**

Scholarships are awarded on merit for outstanding achievements or abilities, NOT financial circumstances.
