The following bursaries are available at Saint Kentigern College for boys and girls who wish to enter at Year 9 in 2020:

- **Trust Board Scholarships**

The Trust Board Bursary is funded from a number of bequests. Its purpose is to enable attendance at Saint Kentigern College for students who might otherwise have attended the College but whose changed family circumstances mean that they now require financial assistance. A Trust Board Bursary will be awarded to a good all-round candidate who will benefit significantly from a Saint Kentigern education.

- **Walker Foundation Bursary**

This is funded by donations from the Walker Foundation set up under the will of the late Joyce Mary Walker. The Walker Foundation has as its purposes the promotion of education of children in New Zealand and, more particularly, providing opportunities for less privileged children to encourage their educational, sporting, cultural and spiritual development.

A Walker Foundation Bursary will be awarded to a strong all-round candidate for Saint Kentigern College who, through financial circumstances, would not ordinarily have had the opportunity to attend an independent school.

Bursaries will provide a discount of 80% of the tuition fees. The student's family will make a financial contribution to the child's education, covering 20% of the tuition fees, as well as transport and school uniform costs.

Bursaries will be available for five years, subject to annual review. Continuation is subject to good academic performance, exemplary behaviour and participation in the overall life of the College.

The **College Bursary Application Form** must be completed and received by the College no later than Friday 29 March 2019. Please ensure it is accurate and includes the **additional** information listed on page 2 of the form. Do not send original documents or awards.
